Sermon Title: “Night School for
Nicodemus”

Scripture: John 3:1-21 and
Numbers 21:4-9**

Open in Prayer: Lord Jesus, We come humbly to your word seeking to be more like you. Be our amazing teacher as we learn every day we have life when we trust that Jesus is our savior and Lord. In Jesus’ name. Amen.

Fellowship Question: Can you name a Christian that has a powerful story of how they came to faith?

Take Time To Read The Scripture: in John 3:1-21 and Numbers 21:4-9 in the Voice

Study Questions for the Sermon and Text: (choose as needed)

- What did you learn about Nicodemus in this passage?
- Do you know someone who might be lost and may not know it?
- Tell your own story of when you came to be a believer and how that connects with the Nicodemus’ narrative?
- Have you seen the power of Jesus to change people for the good? Who is it?
- Does having eternal life change how you live your life?
- Are there clever ways you can share the gospel this week? What are they?

The Challenge: To be a believer requires that we are born again through the water of baptism and that Jesus is the son of God.

Prayer Options: (choose as needed for your group)

- Pray for the Pastor Nominating Committee as they work to find a new pastor.
- Pray for WPC and our shut-ins who need prayer support.
- Pray for our homeless.
