### **Study Questions for the Sermon and Text:**

Reflecting on Proverbs 3:1-10, Acts 2:42-47, and the WPC sermon from May 27, 2018.

- 1) What is one thing (a skill, talent, resource, etc.) that you enjoy sharing with others?
- 2) What is something that is difficult for you to share?
- 3) Read Proverbs 3:1-10
  - a) Reflect on Proverbs 3:5-6, and the concept of trust. What does it look like to “trust the Lord your God with all your heart”? Are there any areas in your life where it is more difficult to trust God? What are they?
  - b) The picture painted in Proverbs 3:9-10 is one that reflects a culture centered on agriculture. What does it look like for you to “honor the Lord with all your substance” in Southern California, today?
- 4) Read Acts 2:42-47
  - a) What word or phrase would you use to describe the priorities of the early Christian community?
  - b) How was someone “added” to the early church?
  - c) What were the early believers doing when they broke bread?
  - d) Pastor Dave mentioned four commitments that the early church made. What were they? What happened because of their commitment?
- 5) In what ways does WPC look like the church described in Acts 2:42-47? How does WPC differ from the Acts church? Is it realistic to think that today’s church should reflect the church Luke describes?
